Post meeting Tom received an email response from someone else from the parks department and said this would need to go through the City Council for approval so long process to get approved. Tom discussed the issue about the trees along 25<sup>th</sup> Street. He had received 3 quotes from three different nurseries for cost of trees and planting trees. All seem about the same. Around \$100.00 a piece to plant the trees. He talked with Trees, Shrubs and More and they said the best time to plant is the spring or fall. Tom called the pipeline company and they recommended trees planted 40 feet from pipeline although current trees are much closer. To be discussed further at next board meeting.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

The "Yard of The Month" for June 2024 is 9308 S. 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. Hilary has given them \$40.00 credit on their dues and will issue a nice certificate. James has moved the sign.

The dead tree along 25<sup>th</sup> Street has been cut down. Utility companies mark flags for the stump removal but it has not been done yet. Tom will contact the tree service to get an update on removal. Being there has been so much tree damage from recent storms, that may be low priority.
